



Guest Rules & Policies

Members have the right to invite guests to use the Club facilities, so long as they are in compliance with the Club's rules related to guests. This includes limitations on the number of times a particular guest may use the Club's facilities during a single membership year.

Guest Passes

- Guest passes may be administered at the Receptionist desk in the main lobby
- An individual guest is permitted to hold a guest pass for a total of 30 days in a fiscal year, for a maximum of 15 days at a time (any one stay greater than 15 days will require renewal)

Gym & Fitness Center

- Guests unaccompanied by a member require guest passes for entry
- The Fitness Center is open to guests after 11:00 AM
 - Guests wishing to visit sooner will incur a fee of \$10 (per guest). This applies whether or not a member is with them

Golf

Guests of Golf members are permitted play no more than 6 times per person, per year. Fees are applied.

Tennis & Pickleball

- Guests of Tennis members are permitted to play any time. Fees are applied
- Guests of Social members may play Tennis after 12:30 PM
- There are no time restrictions for Pickleball or Member-accompanied guests. Guest Fees are applied

Pool

- Guests are allowed unlimited pool time during the Summer, so long as they are accompanied by a member
- From November 1 – April 30, guests are permitted 28 “guest days” at the pool. Any future guest visits after this will incur a fee of \$5 per guest, per day



HOUSE RULES

Failure to adhere to any of the following policies will be subject to a grievance.

DRESS CODE

Panache Lunch

Golf & tennis attire and T-shirts without graphics are permitted. Men are not permitted to wear tank tops. Cover-ups & bathing suits are only permissible for outdoor seating. Appropriate dress jeans are acceptable*

Panache Dinner

Collared shirts required for men | Men are not permitted to wear hats
Men's or Ladies' shorts are not permitted during season
Dress shorts mid-thigh or longer are permitted during off-season with outdoor reservations only
Appropriate dress jeans are acceptable*

Panache Sunday Evening Dinner

Dress shorts mid-thigh or longer & T-shirts without graphics are permitted
Men are not permitted to wear hats or tank tops
Appropriate dress jeans are acceptable*

Oasis Breakfast & Lunch

Golf & tennis attire and T-shirts without graphics are permitted
Bathing suits with cover ups are permitted (no wet bathing suits inside)
Appropriate dress jeans are acceptable*

Mirage Evening Dinner

Collared shirts required for men. Men are not permitted to wear hats
Jackets preferred only during season. Appropriate dress jeans are acceptable*

Card Rooms & Sunset Bar & Lounge

Golf & tennis attire and T-shirts without graphics are permitted
Men are not permitted to wear tank tops
Cover-ups & bathing suits are not permitted
Appropriate dress jeans are acceptable*

DRESS CODE (CONT.)

Members or guests in violation of the dress code in any area of the Club will be asked to leave the premises; those in violation may return when in full compliance with the above dress code policies. **Warnings are no longer issued.**

**Appropriate is defined as no torn, holed, tattered or cut-off of any garment regardless of cost) Members and guests not adhering to the dress codes will be asked to leave and return properly dressed. Should members or guests choose not to return properly dressed, they will be seated, and a grievance will be filed by management and acted upon.*

Please Note: Children ages 16 and older must adhere to the above dress code. Children under 16 are not permitted in the dining room unless accompanied by an adult who shall be responsible for their conduct.

CELL PHONE USAGE POLICY

Please be advised that cellular phone use is restricted to outdoors when in the fitness center, activities center, or main lobby. Phone calls on any outdoor veranda must be taken **away** from dining tables.

Additionally, it is required that you have your phone on the vibrate mode as we understand it is necessary for members to receive phone calls while engaging in activities in the club.

Should you receive such a call, please proceed to one of the areas, so as not to disturb your fellow members in the activities they are participating in.

SMOKING POLICY

In an effort to protect the health and ensure the comfort of all club members and their guests, we have approved the following No Smoking policy. This policy includes cigarettes, E-cigarettes, pipes, and cigars.

Smoking is only permitted in the designated smoking area on the southside of the cardroom terrace and on holes 1-18 on the golf course.

CARD ROOM POLICIES

- Kindly refrain from wearing perfume or cologne in the Card Rooms.
- No outside food or beverages may be brought in or consumed anywhere on Club premises.
 - Card room services are limited to beverages and snacks.
- **Guest Policies:**

October 1 through April 30

Guest players are not permitted in the card room during season except for the following:

- A houseguest with a guest pass is permitted only within the game of the member.
- Members are permitted to bring two (2) guests Monday through Wednesday during the evening. The same guest(s) is only permitted once a week.

May 1 through September 30

- Members are permitted to bring one (1) guest Monday through Friday during the day. The same guest is only permitted once a week.
- Members are permitted to bring two (2) guests Monday through Wednesday during the evening. The same guest(s) is only permitted once a week.

Note: A person is permitted to be a guest only once in any given calendar week. According to club rules and regulations, Aberdeen resident nonmembers may not be included as guests.

CANCELLATION POLICIES

Dining Reservations

- There will be a \$10 per person cancellation/no show fee if you do not cancel by 12 pm on the day of your reservation.
- Dining tables are limited to a maximum of 12 people per table inside and 8 people per table outside.
- If you require a larger party than the maximum size table available, please contact Nicole Palaigos, Director of Events.

Social & Club Events

- There will be no cancellation fee if you cancel your reservation up to 7 days prior to the event.
- Reservations cancelled 3 to 6 days prior to the event, will incur a 50% charge.
- Reservations cancelled less than 3 days prior to the event, will be charged the full amount of the event.

SERVICE ANIMALS

Animals are not permitted on Club property unless they are a qualified Service Animal. Service Animals are not pets for support, therapy, or companionship.

PARKING POLICY

Unattended vehicles are not permitted to park in the Golf Bag Drop circle or any unmarked spaces. Parking is only permitted in designated parking spaces. In the event you are unable to find a parking spot, please valet your vehicle.

POLICY FOR NURSES, COMPANIONS, AND AIDES

Members who employ an aide, nurse, or companion (assistant) are requested to direct that person to a nearby designated area when waiting for the member at the Clubhouse or Fitness and Aquatics Facility. Assistant may sit at the card table or dining room table with the member. Hospital scrubs are not acceptable attire for assistants when on the Club's premises.
